Your utility does not provide a senior discount, which is unusual. Your utility also requires up to \$200 for an initial deposit that is returned after 2 years.

Base fee: what your utility charges each month before you even turn the lights on

Rate per kWh : how much your utility charges for each unit of electricity used. On average, households in Georgia use 1,121 kWh per month.



Your electricity utility serves **31,473 customers** and is controlled by the **Albany Utility Board**. Talk to them about making changes to your utility.



An energy burden is the percentage of your income spent on your electricity. In your county, **54.1% of households have a high energy burden** (they spend 6% or more of income on their electricity).



An energy audit measures how much energy your house is wasting because of inefficiency. **Your city utility does NOT provide energy audits (other cities do).**



People with serious illnesses legally can't be disconnected if it will worsen their illness. They must notify their utility. See **Georgia Rule 515-3-2-.03** for details.



We spoke with Albany Utility Board customers who said they had high bills even when they weren't at home all day. Some people's bills were higher than rent. These should not be happening.
