Your utility's disconnection fee is higher than other cities. Your city also does not provide a payment arrangement option, which is unusual.

Base fee: what your utility charges each month before you even turn the lights on

Rate per kWh : how much your utility charges for each unit of electricity used. On average, households in Georgia use 1,121 kWh per month.



Your electricity utility serves **7,063 customers** and is controlled by your **City Council**. Talk to them about making changes to your utility.



An energy burden is the percentage of your income spent on your electricity. In Clayton County, **31.7% of households have a high energy burden** (they spend 6% or more of income their on electricity).



An energy audit measures how much energy your house is wasting because of inefficiency. **Your city utility provides free energy audits.**



People with serious illnesses legally can't be disconnected if it will worsen their illness. They must notify their utility. See **Georgia Rule 515-3-2-.03** for details.
