Your utility's base fee, late fee, and reconnection fee are all higher than other cities. Seniors are not charged a late fee but additional discounts on their bills are unknown.

Base fee: what your utility charges each month before you even turn the lights on

Rate per kWh : how much your utility charges for each unit of electricity used. On average, households in Georgia use 1,121 kWh per month.



Your electricity utility serves **3,384 customers** and is controlled by your **City Council**. Talk to them about making changes to your utility.



An energy burden is the percentage of your income spent on your electricity. In your county, **48.2% of households have a high energy burden** (they spend 6% or more of their income on electricity).



An energy audit measures how much energy your house is wasting because of inefficiency. **Your city utility does NOT provide energy audits (other cities do).**



People with serious illnesses legally can't be disconnected if it will worsen their illness. They must notify their utility. See **Georgia Rule 515-3-2-.03** for details.



We spoke with a City of Elberton customer who said many people's bills are \$400/month, even on fixed incomes. This is unacceptable.
