Your city does not provide a senior discount on bills, which is unusual. However, they do exempt seniors from late fees.

Base fee: what your utility charges each month before you even turn the lights on

Rate per kWh : how much your utility charges for each unit of electricity used. On average, households in Georgia use 1,121 kWh per month.



Your electricity utility serves **3,034 customers** and is controlled by your **City Council**. Talk to them about making changes to your utility.



An energy burden is the percentage of your income spent on your electricity. In your county, **22.5% of households have a high energy burden** (they spend 6% or more of their income on electricity).



An energy audit measures how much energy your house is wasting because of inefficiency. **Your city utility does NOT provide energy audits (other cities do).**



Your bill is considered **late the next day** after due date. People with serious illnesses legally can't be disconnected if it will worsen their illness. See **Georgia Rule 515-3-2-.03** for details.



We spoke to a City of Fairburn customer whose monthly bill kept getting unexpectedly higher. The utility was unwilling to adjust their bill until their apartment management called the utility for them.
