Your utility charges a \$30 reconnection fee during business hours and \$65 outside business hours, which is high. An initial deposit is required for some customers.

Base fee: what your utility charges each month before you even turn the lights on

Rate per kWh : how much your utility charges for each unit of electricity used. On average, households in Georgia use 1,121 kWh per month.



Your electricity utility serves **1,655 customers** and is controlled by your **City Council**. Talk to them about making changes to your utility.



An energy burden is the percentage of your income spent on your electricity. In your county, **48.7% of households have a high energy burden** (they spend 6% or more of their income on electricity).



An energy audit measures how much energy your house is wasting because of inefficiency. **Your city utility provides free energy audits.**



Electricity bills are considered **late after the 10th** of the month. People with serious illnesses legally can't be disconnected if it will worsen their illness. They must notify their utility. See **Georgia Rule 515-3-2-.03** for details.



We spoke with a Hogansville customer who said that their bill went from \$195 to \$600 in one month with no explanation. This should not be happening.
