Your utility charges a late fee of 10% more of your bill every day your bill is late. This is unusually high. Your city also does not provide a senior discount, which other cities do.

Base fee: what your utility charges each month before you even turn the lights on

Rate per kWh : how much your utility charges for each unit of electricity used. On average, households in Georgia use 1,121 kWh per month.



Your electricity utility serves **2,239 customers** and is controlled by your **City Council**. Talk to them about making changes to your utility.



An energy burden is the percentage of your income spent on your electricity. In your county, **46% of households have a high energy burden** (they spend 6% or more of their income on electricity).



An energy audit measures how much energy your house is wasting because of inefficiency. **Your city utility does NOT provide energy audits (other cities do).**



Your bill is considered **late the day after it's due**. People with serious illnesses legally can't be disconnected if it will worsen their illness. See **Georgia Rule 515-3-2-.03** for details.



We spoke with a Sandersville customer whose energy bill for one person keeps increasing without an obvious explanation and can be up to \$450. A bill for one person should not be this high.
