Your utility requires deposits of up to \$400 for some customers which is high compared to other cities.

Base fee: what your utility charges each month before you even turn the lights on

Rate per kWh : how much your utility charges for each unit of electricity used. On average, households in Georgia use 1,121 kWh per month.



Your electricity utility serves **13,400 customers** and is controlled by your **elected Utility Commissioner**. Talk to them about making changes to your utility.



An energy burden is the percentage of your income spent on your electricity. In your county, **50.7% of households have a high energy burden** (they spend 6% or more of their income on electricity).



An energy audit measures how much energy your house is wasting because of inefficiency. **Your city utility provides free energy audits.**



Your bill is **late the next business day after a 3-day grace period**. People with serious illnesses legally can't be disconnected if it will worsen their illness. See **Georgia Rule 515-3-2-.03** for details.



We spoke to a Thomasville customer who said that many people of color were having unusually high energy bills even after upgrading appliances and heating/cooling systems.
